Tentative Itinerary

Day 1

Depart for Brussels, Belgium.

Day 2

Arrive in Brussels and board our touring coach.

Visit Henri-Chappelle American soldiers' cemetery and memorial. See the foxholes near the village and search for war souvenirs in the forest. Visit Monchau, Germany, a quaint village with a Christmas market.

Visit the sites of the key battles at Brandenburg and Bergstein in the Huertgen Forest. Continue to the Roer river and explore an intact concrete German bunker. Visit the famous "German Corner" then drive the Romantic Road down the scenic Rhine River Valley viewing castles along the way.

Visit the I.G. Farben Building, General Dwight D. Eisenhower's Supreme Headquarters. Drive to Rothenburg, the oldest preserved medieval town in Germany. Walk along the city walls, stroll the cobblestone streets, and enjoy time to shop. Visit Europe's largest Christmas store and the famous Christmas market. Evening tour in Rothenburg.

Visit the Dachau Concentration Camp. Continue to the Bavarian Alps and the town of Oberammergau, location of the world's first and longest-running Passion Play. Look for locally carved nativity scenes and cuckoo clocks in the local shops. Travel south to Garmisch, a Bavarian town on the border with Austria.

Day 6:

Board a cogwheel train and cable car to the top of the highest peak in Germany, the Zugspitze. This afternoon travel to Schwangau for a tour of the spectacular Neuschwanstein Castle built by Mad King Ludwig. Drive through Austria and Liechtenstein to Klosters/Davos in Switzerland.

Free day to choose between optional activities such as skiing, ice skating, sledding, or shopping and relaxing.

Depart for Zurich for our return flight home to Chicago.
