

## ITINERARY

- Day 1 Nov.28, 2025**  
Flight departure for Brussels, Belgium.

- Day 2 Nov.29, 2025**  
Morning arrival in Brussels and board our coach bus. Visit Henri-Chappelle American Military Cemetery and Memorial. Visit WW2 battlefield locations in and around Lanzareth, Belgium.  
Overnight/ dinner in Vichter, Germany.
- 
- Day 3 Nov.30, 2025**  
Brief morning church service at hotel. Visit key WW2 battlefield sites near Brandenburg and Bergstein, Germany in the Huertgen Forest, including the Roer River crossing. Drive the Romantic Road, Rhine River valley.  
Overnight/ dinner on the Rhine River.

- Day 4 Dec.01, 2025**  
Visit the I.G. Farben Building, General Dwight D Eisenhower's Supreme Allied Headquarters. Brief lunch stop at the Frankfurt old world, outdoor Christmas market. Drive to Rothenburg, the oldest preserved medieval town in Germany. Walk along the city wall, stroll the cobblestone streets, visit Germany's largest Christmas store and enjoy time at another old world, outdoor Christmas market. Evening lamplighter tour available.  
Overnight / dinner.

- Day 5 Dec.02, 2025**  
Visit the "Concentration Camp" in Dachau. Continue towards the Bavarian Alps and the city of Oberammergau, location of the world's first and longest-running Passion Play. Look for locally carved nativity scenes and cuckoo clocks in the local shops. Travel south to Garmisch, a Bavarian town on the border with Austria. Overnight/dinner in Garmisch.

- Day 6 Dec.03, 2025**  
Morning board a cable car to the top of the highest peak in Germany, the "Zugspitze." The world's longest free span and total altitude difference of 1,945 meters. Afternoon travel to Schwangau for a tour of the spectacular Neuschwanstein Castle built by mad King Ludwig. Drive through Austria and Swiss to Klosters/Davos. Overnight/dinner in Davos.
